85th Meeting of Board of Advanced Studies and Research



Despite the financial difficulties, University of Balochistan is providing opportunities for higher education and research. These views were expressed by the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Abdul Nabi while addressing the 85th meeting of Board of Advanced Studies and Research. The meeting was held on 18th October, 2011 and attended by the members of the board including Prof. Dr. Mehrab Khan Baloch (PVC), Dr. Rasool Bakhsh Raisani, Dr. M. Ashfaq Ahmed, Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir, Dr. Mudassir Asrar, Dr. Naheed Haq and Muhammad Iqbal Kasi (Registrar).

The Vice Chancellor said that our university is a

public sector educational institution with several thousand students studying in it. The promotion of quality higher education is the top priority of the university. The scholars must work on new research topics utilizing the contemporary methodologies. It is the moral responsibility of people from all walks of life i.e. public, political and generous people to extend their cooperation to the university and rescue it from financial difficulties. The agenda of the meeting included new M.Phil/Ph.D admissions, new examination system for post-graduate coursework, progress reports and extension cases of the scholars. A number of decisions were taken regarding above matters and various committees were formed.

Board of Advanced Studies Meeting

The adjourned meeting of Board of Advanced Studies and Research (BASR) was held in University of Balochistan and was chaired by the Pro-Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Mehrab Khan Baloch. The meeting was attended by the members of the board

including Dr. M. Ashfaq Ahmed, Dr. Rasool Bakhsh Raisani, Dr. Hameed Shahwani, Pro. Abdul Latif Durrani, Dr. Mudassir Asrar and Dr. Ghulam Mohammad Jaffar. The Pro-Vice Chancellor highlighted the importance and role of BASR in



achieving research objectives of higher education. There is a need that scholars should explore new problems and issues in research pursuits. A large number of students, belonging to various parts of

Balochistan are studying in the University, therefore, it is our moral obligation to facilitate them for acquisition of knowledge.

Press Conference

Addressing a press conference at his office, Vice Chancellor, University of Balochistan, Pro. Dr. Abdul Nabi said that University of Balochistan faces Rs. 406 Million shortfall on verge of closure.

The University of Balochistan (UoB) is facing deficit of Rs. 404 million after the cut in funds for fiscal year 2011-12 by the HEC. The huge cut in funds has left the varsity resources starved and if this deficit is not made up, it will be impossible to run the university and university administration will have no choice but to close it. The current financial deficit has badly affected the educational activities in the varsity, said the vice Chancellor UoB Dr. Prof. Abdul Nabi on Saturday.

Vice Chancellor further said that the University is totally dependent on HEC grants. "We can collect a mere fraction on only 9% for university expenses from tuitions, admission and examination fees while the rest of 91% has to be funded by the HEC", the



Vice Chancellor informed that during the last fiscal year the varsity survived courtesy to Rs. 222 million grant-in-aid by the provincial government and this year the proposed budget of RS.870 million has been slashed by Rs.406 million by HEC.

He maintained that a majority of students comes from underdeveloped and far flung areas of the

province and we cannot charge them huge money. He observed that UoB had to play its employees 50% ad-hoc relief announced by the government in last year's budget and 15% ad-hoc relief announced this year plus the House Requisition Allowance to varsity employees costs Rs.80 million annually but the Governor Secretariat is pressing us to freeze this facility because sufficient funds are not available for running the varsity. He further said that University Act is indispensable for proper administration of Higher Education. He regretted that amendment in University of Balochistan Act

1996 has been pending since long despite the amended act to Quality Education Department and Chancellor Secretariat long ago. He appealed that the amended act has to be passed in the Balochistan Assembly at the earliest so that the financial crisis of UoB could be overcome. He said that UoB is committed to provide quality education with its prime focus on research. He further added that it has been a part of our vision and mission to equip students of the varsity with the art of living as productive member of the society thus contributing to the socio economic uplift of Balochistan.

High Level Meeting

"The educational institutes are essential for the progress and prosperity of a society. They play a pivotal role in elimination of illiteracy. The introduction of Loralai and Turbat sub-campuses will have a significant contribution for the uplift of educational standards. Better educational facilities will be available to students at their doorstep." These views were expressed by the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Abdul Nabi while addressing a high level meeting dealing with master plans of these sub-campuses. The meeting was attended by Mr. Sohail Ahmed Bazai (D.G.), Mr. Muhammad Iqbal Kasi (Registrar), Engr. Shahid Babar, Prof. Akram Dost, Prof. Latif

Durrani and Mr. Ali Nawaz Magsi (Treasurer). The first phase of the project of each sub-campus will include the construction of academic and administration blocks, hostels, residences and boundary wall. The Vice Chancellor remarked that opening of new educational institutes is always pleasant for a society as it opens the pathway towards development. This step will enhance the literacy-rate and will also bring a positive change in the general attitude of the people. It is in the interest of the society to accelerate the work on Loralai and Turbat sub-campuses.

De-Affiliation of Colleges

A high level meeting was held to monitor the progress and performance of affiliated colleges in the light of visits made to these colleges. It was observed that there were a number of ghost colleges. Bogus attendance records were maintained and examination forms of ineligible candidates were sent to the university. Certain colleges were unable to provide quality education due to lack of suitable infrastructure and qualified faculty. It was decided to de-affiliate such colleges which were unable to meet the minimum standards set by the university. The de-affiliated colleges include Vision College of Education (Jinnah Town), Muslim Bagh College of Education (Muslim Bagh), Wipro College of Education

(Ziarat) and Sibi Law College (Sibi). A strict warning was issued to Jhalawan Law College (Khuzdar), Loralai Law College (Loralai) and City School of Law (Jinnah Town) to improve their performance. These law colleges were further directed to deposit outstanding tuition fee, affiliation fee and security dues with university by 15th October, 2011, failing of which will cause the cancellation of affiliation.

Governor Distributed Cheques to 37 Gold Medalists of UoB

Governor Balochistan, Nawab Zulfiqar Ali Magsi distributed cheques for Rs.100000/- each to 39 gold medalists of University of Balochistan. The Chancellor Nawab Magsi announced special prizes

at the convocation of University. Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Abdul Nabi and senior teachers were also present at the occasion.



Minister Ahsan Shah has given 10 million to the Turbat Campus

The Provincial Minister Mr. Syed Ahsan Shah and Haji Muhammad Khan Thor Athman Khail has visited University of Balochistan. The Delegation met with Vice Chancellor of University of Balochistan Prof. Dr. Abdul Nabi. They briefed about education, research and future planning programs in university of Balochistan Quetta. They talked about Turbat and Loralai Campuses and the financial crises of University of Balochistan. They wanted to assist University of Balochistan, It is the need of time to run the Loralai and Turbat Campuses to provide education at their door steps. The provincial Minister Syed Ahsan Shah announced Rs.10 million for Turbat Sub Campus to start the degree- programmes. The Vice Chancellor offered his gratitude to the delegation for the visit of Balochistan University which is the largest educational institution of Balochistan. He stressed on the need of such visits by federal and



provincial Ministers and the representatives of masses in order to assist for restructuring of education process in the province.

The panel of judges for the final round included sitting and retired judges from India and Pakistan. 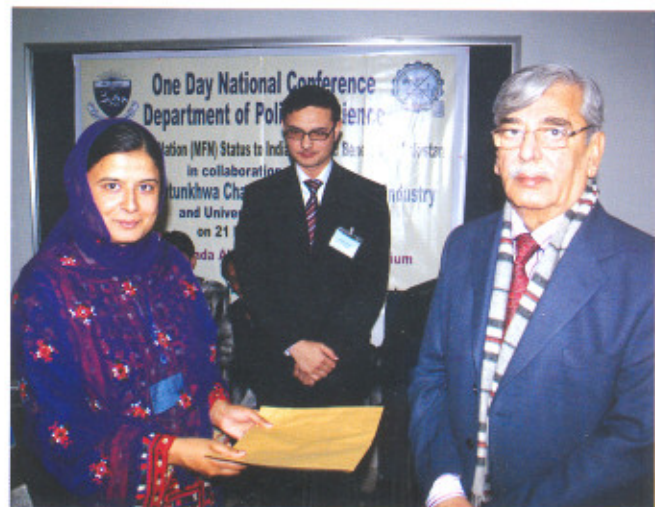


the chairperson of Gender Studies Development Studies Department has participated. They highlighted about the issue of target killing, bodies of missing persons and abduction for ransom. The issue of violence against women and other social evils in which the women is subject to brutal killing in case of honor-killings were discussed.

A Workshop was conducted under the surveillance of Civic Society of Pakistan in Islamabad from 25th-28th November, 2011 to analyse the post-operating era of 18th Amendment in Pakistan. Different bureaucrats, writers, scholars and university professors from all over Pakistan participated in this workshop. Miss Hussan Ara magsi from the University of Balochistan participated to express her views regarding the implementation phase of 18th amendment in Balochistan. It was discussed that although 18th amendment has fully ensured the provincial autonomy in Pakistan. In the province of Balochistan, still the implementation of 18th amendment in transition phase is confronting so many problems to further ensure provincial autonomy. The education, health, forestry, mining,

railways are still supervised by the federal government.

A national conference was conducted on the topic of "MFN (Most Favoured Nations) for India - the



costs and benefits for Pakistan on 21st December 2011, in University of Peshawar. Miss Hussan Ara Magsi presented university of Balochistan Quetta at National forum. The MFN status to India will invite the challenge for Pakistan to compete with India. The local industry of Pakistan will suffer and the Indian goods will seep in the Pakistani market. The plus point for Pakistan will be that free trade will be promoted and bilateral relations with our neighboring country will be improved.

A national forum was held on 22nd January, 2012 under the supervision of SAP-PAK to give coverage to the Judicial system and the place of women in Quetta. Miss Hussan Ara Magsi presented her research paper on the topic: "The judicial system and the place of women in our judicial system. She expressed that women is confronting enormous problems in civil and criminal matters. It is very difficult to get the speedy justice in getting maintenance, divorce, inheritance, murder and minor custody issues.

Seventh Stakeholders' Dialogue for Economic Literacy and Local Ownership of Economic Reforms

The Quetta Workshop was the seventh stakeholders' dialogue under the consultation process spreading over nine workshops involving all stakeholders for creating economic literacy and local ownership of the economic reforms under the Framework for Economic Growth of Pakistan formulated by the Planning Commission and approved by the National Economic Council. It was organized by the University of Balochistan, Quetta in collaboration with the Planning Commission of Pakistan, the Governance Institutes Network International (GINI) and DFID on 15th October, 2011. In view of security concerns, the workshop was held at the Quetta Club. Against the planned participation of 70, the workshop was attended by over 100 participants.



The Vice Chancellor University of Balochistan, Quetta, Prof. Dr. Abdul Nabi in his inaugural address welcomed all the participants of the workshop. He appreciated the efforts of the Governance Institute Network International (GINI) & Planning Commission of Pakistan and support from Department for International Developments (DFID) for providing an opportunity to the University of Balochistan Quetta to organize a workshop on such an important issue. He said the Framework would play a vital role in the economic growth, prosperity and development of Pakistan. He stressed on the adoption of more practical approach in development and implementation of the framework by taking into account the real problems and needs of Pakistan. A consistent role of educational institutes with proper

and sustainable planning will be a major shift in creating technical educational centers is required. In the opening remarks by Mr. Ghulam Mohyuddin Marri, Member Infrastructure explained the main objectives of the Framework for Economic Growth of Pakistan. He said consultation and coordination process would help in refining the proposed framework. He requested the participants to lead and guide for the development and refinement of the proposed document presented in the workshop. The stakeholders' input would be incorporated in the implementation of this strategy/framework. After 18th amendment in the Constitution, provincial role is enhanced in policy planning and making effective implementation



efforts. After devolution of many departments and ministries/subjects to provincial governments, it is now the responsibility of the provincial governments to manage resources and arrange financial and administrative structures.

He assured to use every forum for genuine demands of employees and welfare of university.
