- 2. Climate Change; threats and opportunities
- 3. Linking artificial Intelligence to sustainable development
- 4. Water and Food Security to avert the climate crises.
- 5. Importance of waste management for sustainable living

Deadline for the submission of essay is June 25th, 2021, 11:00pm PKT. The essay shall not exceed 1000-1500 words.
