B: The Manuscripts which focuses the English, Urdu, Balochi, Pashto or other Languages & Literatures would not be published in Al-Burz.

Focus of Al-Burz

Al-Burz is an open access journal which focus on publishing original and peer reviewed research papers on all aspects of Languages, Literature, Linguistics, Culture and History. And the topics include but not limited to

- The Knowledge Base of Language, Social, Cultural, and Political Contexts of Language
- Collaborations & Practices of Language
- The transformative nature of the role of language and communication in human cognition
- Voice input and output, Phonology and morphology
- Lexical semantics and word sense, Grammars, syntax, semantics and discourse
- Literature and Film / Language and Power
- Language and Gender / Language and the New Media
- Role of Balochistani and Asian languages in globalised contexts
- Language, Identity and Culture/ Language and Literature
- Legal translation and courtroom interpreting/ Research on legal language teaching
- Impacts of CPEC on Balochistani languages and Literature.

Peer Review Process

All submitted papers are subject to strict double-blind peer review process by at least one international and one national reviewer that are experts in the area of the particular paper. The peer review process can take anywhere between 30 to 45 days. The aim of the review process is to identify the strengths and weaknesses of the article, in terms of originality, interest, up-to-dates, coherence, and balanced argumentation. The factors that are chiefly taken into account in review are as follows:

- **Relevance:** Is this paper relevant for the topics of this journal?
- **Soundness:** Is this paper technically sound and complete?
- **Are the claims supported by experimental/theoretical results?**
- **Significance:** Is the paper interesting for other researchers?
- **Originality:** Are the results/ideas novel and previously unknown?
- **Readability:** Is the paper well-organized and easy to understand?
- **Language:** Is the paper written in correct Bráhuí and English and style?

Of these, the main factors taken into account are significance and originality. After the double-blind peer review of a manuscript, the corresponding author will receive an email in which s/he will be informed of the status of the manuscript. The possible decisions include

- acceptance
- acceptance with major or minor revisions
- or rejection (Articles that are often rejected include those that are poorly written or organized or are written in poor Bráhuí or English)

In most cases, Alburrrz reviewers recommend that authors revise their manuscripts and send their revisions to Alburrrz for further processing. In such cases, authors may want to accept some of the comments and suggestions that have been made by the reviewers, and at the same time refute some others. It is strongly recommended that authors send in a 'rebuttal' note in which they respond to all of the comments and suggestions made by the reviewers in an item-by-item fashion. They should clearly show which comments and suggestions they accept, and which comments and suggestions they refute. Where a comment or suggestion is refuted, the author is expected to provide the reason why. However, if authors are encouraged to revise and resubmit a submission, there is no guarantee that the revised submission will be accepted. Rejected articles

will not be re-reviewed. Articles may be rejected without review if the Editor-in-Chief considers the article obviously not suitable for publication. The paper acceptance is constrained by such legal requirements as shall then be in force regarding libel, copyright infringement and plagiarism. No research can be included in more than one publication.

Section Policies Original Research Articles

The articles should be original and should neither been previously published nor been under consideration by other journals. These articles are characterized with detailed studies that report original research and are exclusively based on primary data. The original articles should contain:

- Abstract: 150 -250 words including objective/s, methodology, results and conclusion.
- Key Words: 5-7 words
- Methodology/Material
- Results
- Discussion
- Conclusion
- Bibliography / Tables

A manuscript for original articles should be between 10-15 typewritten pages (including tables, figures, graphs and List of References)

Review articles provide an overview on the “state of the art” in a particular area. These articles are focused on identifying specific problems or issues and on analyzing information. The review articles are based on already published literature. However, the review articles should not be based exclusively on summarizing the existing literature, but should contain critiques, issues, and problems that define the field.

The abstract should contain 150-250 words.

A manuscript for Review Articles should be between 10-15 typewritten pages (including tables, figures, graphs and List of References).
