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Leadership behavior in Sub-urban High-performing Schools in Quetta: A Qualitative Study

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Abstract

The success of schools largely depends on their leadership. This paper reports on the findings of two cases, aiming to explore the leadership behavior in two suburban high-performing schools in thecapital city of Balochistan province known as Quetta.For data collection, 12 participants were selected from both schools comprising on senior teachers, principals, and vice-principals.The data wereanalyzed through aninductive exploratory method based on grounded theory approach. The data indicated that leaders in suburban high-performing schools possessed multiple and adaptive leadershipbehaviors. They were focused on change and improvement, building astrong relationship with school members, and assigning and clarifying tasks.
